

Lesson Policies and Pricing

I currently offer two payment plans for my in-person students: Monthly Tuition and Pay-As-You-Go. Online students must enroll in the Monthly Tuition plan.

Monthly Tuition:

For this option, I charge a flat monthly fee for weekly lessons, regardless of how many lessons fall within that month. Students that pay with this method must prepay for the entire month, either by enrolling in AutoPay with a credit or debit card via the *My Music Staff* portal on my website, or by paying with cash, Venmo, CashApp, or Zelle. My rates are as follows:

Tuition for weekly 30-minute lessons: \$120/ month

Tuition for weekly 45-minute lessons: \$160/ month

Tuition for weekly 60-minute lessons: \$200/ month

This plan requires that the student find a consistent, weekly time slot for lessons. If the student needs to cancel a lesson, I will do my best to reschedule it for later that week, though I do not guarantee a rescheduled lesson. If for any reason I need to cancel a weekly lesson, I will credit 25% of the monthly tuition back to the student's account.

Pay-As-You-Go:

For this payment option, payment is required at the conclusion of each lesson. I do not offer this option for online students. I accept Venmo, CashApp, credit card, and cash payments.

Pay-As-You-Go 30-minute lesson: \$40

Pay-As-You-Go 60-minute lesson: \$60

House Calls:

I am available to provide in-home lessons in the greater Sarasota area, depending on the specific location. This service adds a minimum of \$50 to the monthly tuition, or \$20 per Pay-As-You-Go lesson. If the lesson is for a minor, I require an adult to be present in the home at all times during the lesson.

Trial Lesson:

I offer a single 30-minute trial lesson to all new students on Zoom or at my home studio. I do not offer a trial lesson for house calls.

Maintenance & Repairs:

I offer instrument maintenance free of charge for all in-person regular students on select instruments. I may charge students for additional parts if needed. This includes re-stringing, action adjustment, and nut/saddle adjustment.
